



Full SCIP- R has returned!

We've made some changes to these training's to ensure the safety of all participants.

Full SCIP - R (Hybrid)

*October 21st & 22nd - 9:30 AM- 3:30 PM (virtual)
October 23rd - 9:30 AM- 4:30 PM (in person at IAC)*

The 3 day SCIP-R training will be the Core. Participants will learn safe & effective approaches to working with consumers who exhibit aggressive behaviors. Participants will also learn appropriate calming techniques, preventive strategies to de-escalate adverse situations & proper techniques for physical intervention when all else fails.

This training will be done using a hybrid model for safety of attendees and also to minimize physical distance as best as possible during the pandemic. We have adjusted the days utilizing the hybrid model. The training sessions will be a total of 19 learning hours. Two days virtually through the online Zoom platform, 6 hours per day. The final day will be the physical/ intervention techniques, for 7 hours in person utilizing **indoor space at IAC**.

For the in person session (3rd day) registrants will be required to complete a health screening and complete a survey prior to attending in person session. If at the time an attendee presents with COVID related symptoms they will need to reschedule and must notify their employer. To be eligible for SCIP training, all registrants are required to complete a brief COVID safety course.

General Hygiene Safety:

Attendees must have their own PPE (masks, facial shields and gloves) at the time of the session. IAC will supply hand sanitizers to help with hygiene safety.

The person interventions/physical techniques will be broken down and explained in sequential steps. Training participants will practice each step on their own, within their own social space. Once they are proficient in executing the movement, they will work with a partner for brief contact for coaching and testing. Contact will be done with PPEs, brief and efficient.

Training Capacity:

The training session will be capped at **10** participants per class.

Technology Requirements:

Participants must have reliable internet, computer with both audio/visual; throughout the entirety of sessions, participants must be visible to the instructor.
